## July: Monthly statistics

The number of customers at Avanza has during 2018 increased by 74,600, amounting to 8,800 new customers in July. This resulted in 785,200 customers at the end of the month. Net inflow in July was SEK 2,680\*m, amounting to SEK 15,500\*m during 2018.
